




### It all started with ARRA



Health spending and life expectancy, 1970-2017\*, selected OECD countries


Life expectancy at birth, years


### Affect of Office of National Coordinator on EHR adoption





# **COVID Related Telemedicine Leap**

- Main Motivation: Policy not Technology
- Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
  - Waiver to Pay for TM
  - Waiver to Pay for Telephone
  - Waiver to cross state lines
  - These are waiver, not laws
    - Not clear what will remain post-COVID
- Social Distancing
  - Patients and Doctors Understand the Need and Find it works well
    - Pick the right circumstance and patients
